WAIVER OF OBLIGATION UNDER BOND.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, whereas, on the 13th day of February 1908, the Secretary of the Interior approved an oil and gas mining lease on the allotment of Neppie Sunday said allotment embracing the following described lands:

NOW, THEREFORE, I the said Hayward Hayden for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby relieve and release the United States of America from all further obligations and duties under said lease to the Duquense Oil and Gas Company and under said bond made by the United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company, as surety, and

DO HEREBY SUBMITTER for the United States Indian Agent, Union Agency, Muskogee, Oklahoma, the First National Bank, Cawaco, Oklahoma, as a place of payment of the rentals and royalties under said lease, do hereby authorize the lessee and his assigns to pay all rentals and royalties falling due under said
