Witnesseth, that, whereas, by virtue of an order or sale issued out of and under the seal of the District Court of the Twenty-first Judicial District of the State of Oklahoma, in and for Tulsa County, attested the 9th day of August, 1909, upon a judgment for the sum of Two Hundred Seventeen and 35/100 (\$217.35) dollars, and sixty nine and 45/100 (\$69.45) as costs recovered in said Court (or filed in said Court) on the 5th day of May 1909, in case No. 1084 and duly docketed in said court, said judgment being in favor of Peoples Wood Working Co., corporation and against Glenn Pool Building and Investment Co., a corporation, said judgment declaring the following described real estate to be charged with the payment of said judgment, to-wit:
