Whereas, Joseph W. Chambers, an allottee of the CHEROKEE Nation has made application for the removal of restrictions from the following described land, to-wit:

Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen, East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 30 acres more or less.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress, approved May 27, 1908, (Public No. 140), and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said above described land without conditions concerning terms of sale and disposal of the proceeds said removal of restrictions to be effective thirty days from date hereof.
