## DEED OF RELEASE.

North Half (1/2) of lot five (5) in Block One Hundred Seventy five (175) in the town of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the Government plat and survey thereof.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of Mortgage dated December 1st 1904, and recorded December 20 1904, in Book N. at Page 129 of the records at Sapulpa, Ind. Ty., wherein Loren Conaway and Ida C. Conaway conveyed said real estate to M.V. Erick to secure the payment of one certain promissory note therein named, the same having been fully paid.

Cooper, guardian of Ethel Bough, a minor, of Broken Arrow, I.T. party of the first part, lessor and HINSHALL OIL & GAS COMPANY of Tulsa, Indian Territory, party of the second part, lessees, under and in pursuance of the provisions of section 17 of the act of Congress approved June 30, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior thereunder.
