Castille, Guardian of Myrtle Hewlett, a minor, of Broken Arrow, I.T. party of the first part, lessor---and MINSHALL OIL & GAS COMPANY of Tulse, Indian Territory, party of the second part, lessee, under and in pursuance of the provisions of section 17 of the act of Congress approved June 30, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior the reunder.

WITHESSERH, that the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the royarties, covenants, stipulations, and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the party of the second part, its heirs, successors, and assigns, does hereby demise, grant, and let unto the party of the second part, its heirs, successors, and assigns, for the term of ending Feby. 16th, 1922 years from the date hereof, all of the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the rollowing described tract of land, lying and being within the Creek Indian Nation and within the Indian Territory, to-wit: The Lot 4 and N.
