## ORDER APPROVING OIL AND GAS LEASES.

Now on this 17th day of December, 1909, the same being a regular Probate Day of the County Court of Muskogee County, Oklahoma, this cause comes regularly on for nearing upon the petition of Willie C. Davis to approve an oil and gas lease made by him as guardian on the North-west quarter of Section Twenty-six (26) township Nineteen (19) north, range thirteen (13) East in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, the property of Clifford Davis, a minor; also to approve an oil and gas lease made by him as guardian on the south-west quarter of section twenty-six (26) township nineteen (19) north, range thirteen (13) East in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, the property of Rosie Davis, a minor; and also for approval of an oil and gas lease made by him as guardian on the north-east quarter of section twenty-six (26) township nineteen (19) north, range thirteen (13) East, the property of Herbert Davis, a minor; all of said leases being made to A.F. Ault of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the minority of each minor and for as much longer as oil and gas may be found for a cash bonus of 65 cents per acre for each tract of land heretofore described separately, for a 1/8 royalty of all oil produced on each of said tracts of land, for the sum of \$80. cash payable in advance each year for each tract of land until a well shall be drilled thereon, and for \$150 for each producing gas well on each of said tracts of land where gas is used for other purposes than in operating said oil well or wells to be drilled on each tract of land. That all of said leases were executed by said guardian on the 15th day of December, 1909, to A.F. Ault aforesaid.

The court having examined the petition for an order approving said leases, all of said leases and the evidence tendered in support of said petition finds that said leases are in all respects fair and that the amount offered for each lease is reasonable and to the best interest of the estate of each minor that said lease on his land afore-described should be proved
