premises, of all crude oil extracted from the said land, and if the parties do not, before the tenth day or the month succeeding its extraction, agree upon the value of the crude oil on the leased premises, the value thereof shall finally be determined under the direction of the Secretary of the Interior of such memner as he shall prescribe, and to so pay the royalty accruing for any month on or before the twenty fifth day of the month succeeding, and where the value of the crude oil fluctuates, the average value during the north shall constitute the criterior in commuting the royalty and to pay in yearly payments at the end of each year, one hundred and firty dollars royalty on each gas producing well, the lessor to have free the use of gas for lighting and warming his residence on the remises. But failure on the part of the lessee to use a gas-producing well, where the same cannot be reasonably utilized at the rate so prescribed, shall not work a forfeiture of this lease so far as the same relates to mining oil, but if the lessee desires to retain gas-producing privileges it shall pay a royalty of fifty dollars per annum on each gas producing well not utilizedthe first payment to become due and to be made within thirty days from the date of the discovery of gas, payments thereafter for such wells to be made in advance at the first of each succeeding year, dating from the first payment.

And the party of the second part further agrees and binds itself, its successors and assigns, to pay or cause to be gaid to the lessor, as advanced annual royalty on this lease, the sums or money as follows, to-wit: Fifteen cents per acre per annum, in advance, for the first and second years; Thirty cents per acre per annum in advance, for the third and fourth years; and Seventy five cents per acre per annum, in advance, for the rifth and each succeeding year thereafter of the term for which this lease is to run; it being understood and agreed that said sums of money so gaid shall be a credit on the stipulated royalties should the same exceed such sums paid as advanced royalty, andfurther, that should the party of the second part neglect or refuse to pay such advanced annual royalty for the period of sixty days after the same secones due and payable, then this lease shall at the option of the lessor, so mult and void, and all royalties gaid in advance shall passon the money and property of the lessor.

The party of the second part further coverants and agrees to exercise didigence in the sinking of wells for oil and natural gas on the lands covered by this lease, and to drill at lease one well thereon within twelve months from the date of the approval of the bond by the Sectebary of the Interior, and should the party of the second part, rail, neglect, or refuse to drill at least one well within the time stated, this lease may, in the discretion of the Secretary of the Secretary, se declared null and void, with due notice to the lessee and proof or the default; and said party of the second part agrees to operate the same in a workmalike manner to the rullest poscible extent, unavoidable casualties, excepted; to commit no waste upon the said land, and to suffer no waste to be committed upon the portion in its occupancy or use, to take good care or the same, and to promptly surrender and return the premises upon the termination of this lease to the party of the first part or to chooseever chall be law-
