

That for the purpose of protecting the lands of the said minor, ward and securing her full share of all of the oil thereunder, it is necessary to erect and maintain upon said land, steel storage tanks for said oil

That the reasonable rental value of the grounds used for such tanks is the sum of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per year for each tank.

That your petitioner has entered into a contract with Robert W. Morrison, Charles W.S. Cobb, John E. McKinney, W.J. Breene and Frank M. Breene a copy of which is attached hereto, giving to said parties, their heirs, successors and assigns, the right to erect and maintain said steel tanks and to sell and assign the same to such parties as they may desire when the same are filled with oil.

That said contract is for the best interests of said estate and your Curator recommends that the same be approved and prays that an order be entered by this court, ratifying, approving and confirming the same.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this Second day of January, 1908 between Bates B. Burnett, Curator of the Estate of Edith Durant, a minor, of Boynton, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and Robert W. Morrison, Charles W.S. Cobb, John E. McKinney, of St Louis, Missouri, William J. Breene, of Oil City, Pennsylvania and Frank M. Breene, of Bartlesville, Oklahoma, parties of the second part, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Monday Durant, as Guardian of Edith Durant, made and executed an oil and gas lease to the Galbreath Oil & Gas Company, on the East one-half (1/2) of the North-west quarter (1/4) of Section Fifteen (15), Township Seventeen (17), Range Twelve (12), Creek Nation, Indian Territory (now Oklahoma); and,

WHEREAS, said lease was approved by the Department of the Interior.

WHEREAS, said Galbreath Oil & Gas Company assigned said lease upon the South-east Quarter (1/4) of the North-west quarter (1/4) of Section Fifteen (15), Township Seventeen (17), Range Twelve (12), Creek Nation, Indian Territory, (now Oklahoma) to the parties of the second part herein; and,
