Breene, of Bartlesville, Oklahoma, shall have the right to erect and maintain steel tanks upon the allotment of said minor described in said petition, and the said parties shall have the right to sell and assign the same, when desired, and the Court being sufficiently advised, finds that such a contract will be of advantage to the estate of said minor, and it is to the best interests of said minor and her estate that the same be approved. Such contract being submitted and the Court being satisfied that the same is in proper form,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the rental contract made and entered into by the said Curator with said parties dated the 20th day of January, 1908, be and the same is hereby in all things approved ratified and confirmed.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, Vera, McKinney of said county and stated, for and in consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by The Texas Company, a corporation, do hereby grant, and convey unto it, the said The Texas Company, its successors and assigns the right to construct, operate and maintain a spur line of standard gauge railroad track on and over a certain portion of N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 23, Township 19 N. Range 12 E. in Tulsa, County, Oklahoma, said spur track to leave the Midland Valley Railroad at a point directly opposite its Lefebvre water tank and extend from the right of way of said railroad north 10 degrees west a distance of 1161 feet to a point where it leaves my land and enters the lands of The Texas Company, said point being 1623 feet west of the northeast corner of Section 23, Township 19 N. Range 12 E. including the necessary right of way 50 feet in width, being 30 feet on the west side and 20 feet on the east side of the center of said track.
