RENTAL CONTRACT.

This Agreement made and entered into this the 29th day of December 1909 by and between Maggie Grayson nee Drew and her husband Henry Grayson party of the first part, and T.L. Mathews party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the agreement herein-after named by the party of the second part that the party of the first part has this day rented unto the party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, for farming purposes, for the term of five years from the 29th day of Dec. 1909 the following described farm or parcel of land, to-wit:

I.M. for \$- - - - - per annum as follows \$One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in advance, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and \$- - - - - first day of - - - - - 180-- and if grain or part of the crop paid as follows: 1-----, and of cotton 1-----and if any improvements made as follows: Second party to move a certain house from the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of above described section to the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ above described land, build a common log stable, and repair the fence now on the place.
