## OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE.

UPON 3 LANDS OWNED FOR ALLOCATING CHEROKEE NATION INDIAN TERRITORY.  
(Section 72 Act of July 1, 1902 34 Stat 716, 726)

THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 28<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1905, by and between Harry J. Walkley Curator of George West Jr. a minor born September 2nd 1892 of Claremore, Indian Territory, party of the first part, and Penn Oil Company, a corporation, organized and existing under and by virtue of the Laws of the United States in force in the Indian Territory of Bartlesville, Indian Territory, party of the second part, under and in pursuance of the provisions of section 72 of the Act of Congress approved July 1, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior thereunder.

WITNESSETH: That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the royalties, covenants, stipulations, and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid observed and performed by the party of the second part, its successors and assigns, does hereby demise, grant, and let unto the party of the second part, its successors and assigns, for the term of ending September 1st, 1915, years from the date hereof, all of the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following, described tract of land lying and being within the Cherokee Indian Nation and within the Indian Territory, to-wit: The South Half of North East quarter of section Twenty Seven (27) Township Twenty-one (21) North, range Thirteen (13) east, of the Indian Meridian and containing eighty (80) acres more or less with the right
