

WARRANTY DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, made 19th, day of May 1909, between the Tulsa Addition Company, a corporation, having its principal place of business at Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the first part and Vernon A. Cobb, of Tulsa, Okla., party of the secondpart:

WITNESSETH: That said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate situate in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots One (1) and Two (2) in Block Fortx Three (43), in the Owen Addition of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the amended plat thereof, dated April 25, 1907, and duly filed for record.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with and the singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining forever.

Party of the first part for itself, its successors and assigns does hereby warrant promise and agree to and with the saidparty of the secondpart, that at the time of the delivery of these presents, it is lawfully seized in fee in its own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein in Fee Simple, of and in and all and singular the above granted and described premises with all the appurtenances; that the same are free, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former ^{and other} grants, titles, charges, estates, judgements, taxes, assessments and incumbrances of what nature or kind soever and that it will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns against said party of the first part its successors and all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
