That I caused the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twelve, Township Nineteen North, Range Twelve East to be platted into Lots and Blocks, and to be known as the Horner Addition; which plat was filed June 29th 1907 and recorded in Book 12 at Page 639 in the office of the Deputy U. S. Clerk at Tulsa Indian Territory.

That I later by Warranty Deed conveyed to L. K. Cone the following described land, to-wit:

The South Thirty Feet of Lot One (1), all of Lots Two (2), Three (3) Four (4) Five (5) and Six (6) in Block Six (6) of the Horner Addition to Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the official survey and recorded plat thereof. Said deed being recorded Book 25, Page 602, Register of Deeds Office, Tulsa, Okla., Tulsa County.

That in each of the proceedings and instruments named above, and in fact in all instruments in the course of the title of said land and property, Ella Harner and Ella Horner are one and the same persons, and I am that person.

I further state that in a certain action in the District Court of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, entitled Ella Horner, Plaintiff vs. Mike Horner, Defendant, wherein Decree was rendered November 17th, 1908, I am the Plaintiff therein named, and at the time of the execution of said deed to L. K. Cone, recorded in Book 45, at page 602, Register of Deeds Office, at Tulsa, Oklahoma, Said Mike Horner was my husband.

THIS INSTRUMENT, Made executed and delivered, this 25th, day of May 1909, by and between J. W. McLoud, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and A. Lloyd, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Fifty (550) Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the first party has granted, bargained sold and conveyed, and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the second party, his heirs and assigns, the following described real property, lying and situate in the town of Skiatook, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots Nine (9) and Ten (10) Block Twenty Four (24), according to the recorded plat thereof, together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.
