Feland and Lee Settle, hereinafter referred to as the lessees, their heirs successors and assigns, all the oil and gas in and under the following described premises, together with the exclusive right to enter thereon at all times for the purpose of drilling and operating for oil, gas or water, and to erect, install and maintain all buildings and structures, machinery and appliances, and lay all pipes nemessary for the production, storage and transportation of oil, gas or water upon and from said premises.
