The deed claimed by S. F. Jones is a forgery; that is, I did not make it nor know anything about it. The Notary Public has read and explained this statement to me before I signed it or swore to it. Fetzer and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 771 feet South of the quarter section corner between Sections Eleven (11) and _welve (12) , Township Nineteen (19) North of Range _welve (12) East and running thence on a magnetic course South 74 degrees West 444 feet to the left bank of the Arkansas River, thence down said bank to its intersection with the section Line between Sections 11 and 12, Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East, thence North along said Section Line to place of beginning, being Three ,3) acres more or less out of the Southeast Corner if Lot Seven (7) Section Eleven (11) Township Mineteen (19) North of Range Twelve (12) East:
