lease, the sums of money as follows: to-wit: Fifteen Cents per acre per annum, in advance for the first and second years; Thirty cents per acre per annum, in advance for the Third and fourth years; and Seventy Five Cents per acre per annum, in advance for the fifth and each succeeding year thereafter of the term for which this lease is to run; it being understood and agreed that said sums of money sa paid shall be a credit on the stipulated royalties should the same exceed such sums paid in advance royalty; and further, that should the party of the second part neglect or refuse to pay such advanced andnual royalty for the period of sixty days after the same becomes due and payable, then this lease, shall at the option of the lessor, be null and void, and all royalties paid in advance shall become the money and property of the lessor.

The party of the secondpart further covenants and agrees to exercise diligence in the sinking of wells for oil and gas on lands covered by this lease, and to drill at least onw well thereon within twelve months from the date of the approval of the bond by the Secretary of the Interior, and should the party of the second part fail refuse to drill at least one well thereon within the time stated, this lease may, in the discretion of the Secretary she declared null and void, with due notice to the lessee and proof of the default; and saidparty of the second part agrees to operate the same in a workmanlike manner to the fullest possible extent, unavoidable casualties excepted; to commit no waste upon the saidland and to suffer no waste to be committed upon theportion i n his occupancy or use; to take good care of the same, and to promptly surrender and return the premises upon the termination of this lease to theparty of the first part, or to whomsoeher shall be lawfully entitled thereto, and not to remove thereform and buildings or improvements erected thereon during theterm by the saidparty of the second part, but said buildings and improvements shall remain a part of the Said land, and become the property of the owner of the land as a part of the consideration for this lease, in addition to the other considerations herein specified, excepting that toos, boilers, boiler houses, pipe lines, pumping and drilling outfits, tanks, engines and machinery, and the casing of all dry or exausted wells shall remain the property of the said party pf the second part, and may be removed at any time perfore the expiration of sixty days from the termination of the lease; that he will not permit any nuisnace to be maintained on thepremises under his control, nor allow any intoxicating liquors to be sold or given away for any purposes on such premises; that he will not use such premises for any other purpose than that authorized in this lease, and that before abandoning any well he will securely plug the same so as effectually shut off all water above the oil bearing horizon.

And it is mutually understoof and agreed that no sublease, assignment, or transfer of this lease or of any interest therein or thereinder can be directly or indirectly made without the written consent thereto of thelessor, and the Secretary of the Interior first obtained, and that any such assignment or transfer made or attempted without such consent shall be void.

And the said party of the second part further covenants and agrees that it will keep an accurate account of alloil mining operations, showing the whole amount of oil mined or removed; and all sums due as royalty shall be a lien on allimplements, tools, movable machinery, and other personal chattels used in said prospecting and mining operations and upon all of the unsold oil obtained from the land herein leased, as security for the payment of said royalties.

And the party of the second part agrees that this indenture of lease shall in all respects be subject to the rule and regulations heretofore or that may hereafter be lawfully
