And the said party of the second part expressly agrees that should it or its sublessees, heirs, executors, administrators, successors or assigns, violate any of the
covenants, tipulations, or provisions of this lease, or fail for the period of sixty
days to pay the stipulated royalty provided for herein, then the party of the first part
shall be at liberty, in his discretion to avoid this indenture or lease and cause the
same to be annulled, when all the rights, franchises and privileges of the party of the
second part, its sublessees, heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns
hereunder shall cease and end without further proceedings.

If the lessee makes reasonable and bonafide effort to find and produe oil in paying quantity as is herein required of it, and such effort is unsuccessful, it may at any time thereafter, with the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, surrender and wholly terminate this lease upon the full payment and performance of all its then existing obligations hereunder: Provided, however, That approval of such surrender by the Secretary will be required only dueing the time his approval of the alienation of the land is required by law.

It is further agreed and understood that this lease shall be of no force or effect unless the party of the second part shall, within sixty days from the date of the approval of the application filed in connection herewith, furnish a satisfactory bond in accordance with the regulations of March 20, 1905, prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior which shall be deposited and remain on file in the Indian Office during the life of said
