And the Court having seen said petition, and heard the testimony of witnesses in open court, and being fully advised in thepremises dothafind:

That Rachel Perryman is the widow of george B. Perryman, deceased, and a full-blood Creek Indian; that George B. Perryman was a full blood Creek Indian, and that he dies intestate on or about the --- day of April 1899, being at the time of his death a resident of the City of Tulsa, and that part of the Indian Territory, now included within the limits of Tulsa County; that after the death of said George B. Perryman there was set apart and allotted to the heirs of said deseased 160 acres of land in the Creek Nation, that in a partition thereof the following described tract was set apart in fee to Rachel Perryman, widow of said deceased, to-wit:

Lot One (1) of the West One Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section Twelve (12), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East, containing 2.86 acres, reference being had to final decree in partition rendered at March Term 1905 of the United States Court for the Western District of Indian Territory, at Sapulpa, in cause wherein Emma Drew, et al, were plaintiffs and Legus C. Perryman, Guardian et al. were defendants.

The Court further finds that said Rachel:Perryman, on the 23rd, day of February 1909 sold and conveyed said described tract of land by warranty deed of that date, to C. C. Drew and John F. Lawrence, for the consideration of Two Thousand Dollars, which has been fully paid by said Grantees to said Rachel Perryman.

That said sum is the fair and reasonable value of said tract of land; that this court is the court having jurisdiction of the settlement of the estate of george B. Perryman, deceased, and that said conveyance should be approved.

It is therefore considered, ordered and adjudged by the Court that the deed by the said Rachel Perryman to said C. C. Drew and John F. Lawrence, bearing date of February 23, 1909, conveying the tract of land aforesaid, be and the same is hereby approved.
