THE MUSKOGEE (CREEK) NATION, INDIAN TERRITORY.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, a townsite commission, heretofore appointed and acting under authority of the act of Congress approved March 1, 1901 (31 Stat., 861), agreement ratified by the Creek Nation May 25, 1901, has appraised the lots in the town of Bixby, Oklahoma, formerly Muskogee (Creek) Nation, Indian Territory; and,

WHEREAS, the <sup>plat</sup> ~~part~~ of said town was approved by the Secretary of the Interior on the 10th, day of April, 1902, and was duly placed on file; and,

WHEREAS, The said commission has appraised all of the town lots included in said plat at their true value, excluding improvements, which appraisal has been approved by the Secretary of the Interior; and,

WHEREAS, the said commission has awarded the real estate described hereinbelow to Samuel F. Battershall, who has paid Nineteen & no/100 (\$19.00) Dollars, the full amount of the purchase price, into the treasury of the United States, to the Credit of the Muskogee or Creek Nation of Indians, with the United States Indian Agent, at Muskogee Indian Territory, and is therefore entitled to a patent.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, do, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid Act of Congress of the United States, hereby grant, sell and convey unto the said Samuel F. Battershall, heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation aforesaid in and to Lot Numbered 1, in block numbered 16 in the Town of Bix-
