Smith for and in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 and other good and valuable considerations hereby releases and quit claims all right, title, claim or interest against the Admiral Oil Company by reason of the said inserted clause, to-wit: "Where the capacity is more than Three Million (3,000,000) cubic feet \$50.00 additional for each one million (1,000,000) cubic feet".
