AGRICULTURAL LEASE.

THIS LEASE, Made and entered into this 24th, day of February 1909, by and between William Lucky and Elrena Lucky, Creek Minors, by Dick Lucky their duly appointed and legal guardian, of Wagoner County, Oklahoma, parties of the first part, and W. G. Brockman and Henry C. Brockman, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, parties of the second part:

WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, do by these presents demise, lease and let unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, for agricultural or grazing purposes, for a term of Five (5) years beginning on January first 1914, and expiring on January first 1919, the following described property, situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The West Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Thirty (30), in Township Nineteen (19), Range Eleven (11) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing Three Hundred and Twenty (320) acres more or less as the case may be according to the United States survey thereof.
