I Further direct and request that my said wife shall have a monument of Gray Granite erected and suitable inscribed with the date of our births and deaths thereon and such other inscription as she may deem appropriate, the whole not to cost less than One Hundred Dollars and more at her discretion, all to be paid for by the accumulation of rents over and above her liberal maintenance. The monument so placed as to commemorate the life of each.
