That the said Nancy Ellis died on or about April 29, 1904, at the residence of her father near Skiatook, in what is now the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma. That the said Nancy Ellis was, at the time of her death about twenty years of age, unmarried, and died leaving no issue whatever; that the mother of said Nancy Ellis died about Jan., 15th, in the year 1899; that her only living brother or sister, was Fannie Ellis; That the said Fannie Ellis was the only living brother or sister surviving the said Nancy Ellis; that there was no decendants of her brothers or sister living at the time of bhe death of the said Nancy Ellis.

That the said Nancy Ellis is the same party to whom the Cherokee Nation allotted the Northwest Quart er $(\frac{1}{4})$ of the Southeast Quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ and the Northeast Quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of the Southwest Quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of Section Sevem, Township Twenty One North, Range Thirteen (13) East, and the said Weaver Ellis is the same party to whom was allotted by the Cherokee Nation the East Half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the Southeast Quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of Section Seven, Township Twenty One North, Range Thirteen East.
