That the said Nancy Ellis is the same party to whom the Cherokee Nation allotted the Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and the Northeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Seven, Township Twenty One North, Range Thirteen (13) East and the said Weaver Ellis is the same party to whom was allotted ~~th~~ the Cherokee Nation the East Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Seven, Township Twenty One North, Range Thirteen East.
