# ORDER FOR REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS.

Whereas Emily Depriest, an allottee of the Creek Nation, has made application for the removal of restrictions from the following described land, to-wit:

Lot Four (4) of Section Three (3), Township Sixteen (16) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 52.11 acres, more or less, located in Tulsa County.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, under the authority vested in me by the act of Congress approved May 27, 1909 (Public No. 140), and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restdtions from said above described land, such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of deed by said allottee to F. M. Elsey, of Eufaula, Oklahoma.
