ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 24th, day of July 1909, by and between J. H. Rogers, party of the first part, and C. C. Simmons party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part assigns, sells, transfers and delivers unto the party of the second part all of the right, title and interest in and to one certain oil and gas lease, executed on the 18th, day of December 1907 by Max Rothpletz and wife to said first party said J. H. Rogers, upon the following described property, situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The West One Half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) and the Northeast One Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest One Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Three (3), Township Nineteen (19) Range Thirteen (13) containing One Hundred and Twenty (120) acres, more or less.

It being fully understood and agreed between both the first and second parties hereto that this assignment is given to C. C. Simmons as security for the payment of a note of even date Two Hundred & no/100 Dollars and that on payment of said note, the above described oil and gas lease shall again become the property of the said J. H. Rogers and this instrument void and of no effect. This agreement is binding upon the heirs, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
