RIGHT OF WAY.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF TWENTY FIVE AND 10/100 (\$25.10) Dollars to me in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, John W. Barger and Cora Barber, his wife, do hereby grant to The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, operate and remove a pipe line, diagonally across land, for the transportation of oil and gas and erect, maintain and operate a telegraph or telephone line on the public highway, if the same shall be found necessary, on, over and through mylands, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit:
