RIGHT OF WAY.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF SEVEN and 50/100 (\$7.50) Dollars, to me in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged I, Ophelia McKee and James H. McKee, her husband do hereby grant to The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate and remove a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas and erect maintain and operate a telegraph and telephone line, if the same shall be found necessary, on, over and across my allotted lands, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit:

NW. 1/4 Section 32, Township 17, Range 13 E. with ingress and egress to and from the same. The said grantors heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes herein granted to the said The Prairie Oil and Gas Company which hereby agrees to pay any damages which may arise from the laying, maintaining and operating said pipe line; said damage if not mutually agreed upon to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested parties, one thereof to be appointed by the grantors, heirs or assigns, one by The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, and the third by the two appointed as aforesaid, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive. And it is hereby further agreed, that the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company its successors and assigns, may at any time lay an additional pipe alongside of the first line, as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration, and subject to the same conditions; also to have the right to change the size of the pipes, the damage in making such change to be paid by the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company.

All pipe to be buried and kept buried 18 in. below the surface. Telegraph or telephone line to follow or run along the fence or section lines.
