authorizing and empowering my said attorney for me and in my name, place and stead to intervene in any suits already filed affecting the title to said lands, or to institute separate actions thereform and to do all things and to take such steps as to him may seem necessary and best in his judgement to be done in the premises, to negotiate for a compromise effecting the said premises and to umploy such assistance as to him may seem best, hereby ratifing and confirming all my said attorney may do or cause to be done by said party of the second part in consivirtue hereof; and I hereby agree to give to the deration of his services an undivided one third interest of all that may be recovered for me in the said lands hereinabove described, whether the same may be in moneys, lands or property hereby confirming unto the said party of the second part, his heirs or assigns, the interest above set out, free and clear of all lians and incumbrances of whatsoever kind or nature.

And I the said party of the second part do, for and in consideration of 'he premises hereby agree to diligently prosecute such action as may be instituted, t o pay all expenses thereof, and to do all things necessary to be done to recover the title to thelands above described to the said party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns, and to accept for my services in her behalf the one third interest above set out.

It is further understood and agreed that this contract and the covenants shall extend to and be binding upon our heirs, executors, Administrators and assigns.
