

ASSIGNMENT OF MORTGAGE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

All of its right, title and interest in and to a mortgage and note given to William F. Tucker, et ux. dated the 22nd, day of November 1907, recorded in Volume 30 of Mortgages on page 47 in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, on the following described property to-wit:

Part of Lot Six (6) in Block one Hundred Fifty One (151) in the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the official plat of said City, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the point of intersection of the dividing line between Lots Five (5) and Six (6) in Block 151, where such dividing line cuts the Westerly side of said Block 151; ~~thence in a Northerly direction along the Westerly line of said Lot Six (6) in said Block 151;~~ *a distance of fifty (50) feet to a point*; thence in a Northerly direction along the Westerly side of said Lot Six (6) in said Block 151, a distance of Fifty (50) feet to a point; thence in an Easterly direction on a line parallel with the dividing line between lots five and six a distance of One Hundred Forty (140) feet to a point; thence in a Southerly direction along the Westerly ~~alley~~ *lot* line a distance of Fifty (50) feet to a point; thence along the dividing line between ~~lots~~ *lots* 5 and 6 to place of beginning, being a plot of ground having a frontage of Fifty (50) feet on Denver Avenue and a uniform width of Fifty (50) feet and with a depth of One Hundred Forty (140) feet abutting on lot 5 for its entire depth.
