

RIGHT OF WAY.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF NINE 25/100 ( \$9.25) Dollars to me in handpaid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, Benjamin H. Reddick, single, do hereby grant to the Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain operate and remove a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas and erect, maintain and operate and remove a telegraph or telephone line, if the same shall be found necessary on over and through my deeded lands, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit:

N $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 5, Township 16, Range 13, with ingress and egress to and from the same.

The said grantor heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said The Prairie Oil and Gas Company, which hereby agrees to pay any damages which may arise from the laying, maintaining and operating said pipe line; said damage if not mutually agreed upon, to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the said grantor, heirs or assigns, one by The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive. And it is hereby further agreed, that the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first, as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration, and subject to the same conditions; also to have the right to change the size of pipes, the damage, if any, in making such change to be paid by the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company. Pipe line must be buried 16 inches or more below surface? Telegraph and telephone line to follow Section Lines.
