The verified petition alleges that the said Akie Christie died in Cherokee County, State of Oklahoma, on July 6, 1909, leaving as her sole and only heirs the following named persons, to-wit: Buffalo Christis, husband, aged 49 years; William Christie, son, aged 29 yrs., Jennie Christie, daughetr, aged 27 yrs.,
