

ASSIGNMENT OF MORTGAGE:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

Bear, of the second part, at and before the en sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said party of the second part, a certain Deed of Trust, bearing date the 25th, day of March One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine, made by George V. Tanner and Ada L. Tanner, his wife, of the first part; both of said County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to Floyd W. Corlett and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in Liber 52, at page 368, with all and singular the pre-mises therein mentioned and described, together with the notes or obligation therein also mentioned, and the moneys now due, and the interest that may hereafter grow due thereon:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, forever, subject only to the provisions in the said Indenture or Mortgage mentioned. And I do hereby authorize and appoint the said party of the second part my true and lawful attorney, irrevocably in my name, or otherwise, but at her proper costs and charge, to have, use and take all lawful ways and means for the recovery of the sum or sums of money now due and owing, or hereafter to become due and owing, upon the said notes, and in case of payment to give acquittance or othersufficient discharge, as fully as I might do if these presents were not made; and I do hereby for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant, promise and agree to and with the said party of the first part, that there is due upon the said notes and Deed of Trust the sum of Nine Hundred Forty Five Dollars, to become due at a future date. and that I have good right, and lawful authority to grant, bargain and sell the same in manner aforesaid.
