## RIGHT OF WAY GRANT.

The Northwest Quarter (NW. 1) of Section #30, Township 18 North, Range 13 East:

Also there is hereby granted the sight to erect and maintain a telephone and telegraph line, and shall also permit the grantee herein, its successors and assigns, to do whatever may be necessary to their construction or for the enjoyment of the rights herein granted, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said tract of land for the purpose of laying, maintaining, repairing and restoring of said pipe line and said telegraph and telephone line, and for removing of same when desired by the grantee, its successors and assigns.
