QUIT-CLAIM DEED.—JAMES DODD WORTH BOOK CO., LEAVENWORTH, KAN. NO. 20188

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 9<sup>th</sup> day of December, in the year A. D. 1929, between  
W.M. Pitkin, single man, unmarried  
of the first part, and Fred K. Gleason  
of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other  
unmentionable considerations DOLLARS,  
to James duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto  
the said party of the second part, and to Fred heirs and assigns, forever, all title right, title, interest and  
estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following-described real estate situated in the County of Tulsa  
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

I do set aside, twenty-five feet of the east-seventh line, lot of Lots one, two and three  
(2) block seventy-four (2) if the original town of Tulsa, Oklahoma, more  
particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the southwesterly  
corner of Lot two (2) seventy-five (2) feet southwesterly from the  
southwest corner said lot, thence along said southwest line, northwesterly  
eastwardly about five (5) feet; thence at right angles to said boundary  
line and northerly with the easterly boundary line of lots one (1) and  
two (2) northwesterly and bounded by forty (40) feet to the southwest line  
thence along said easterly boundary line to the southwesterly  
boundary line of block one (1), thence at right angles and parallel to the contract  
line of a side lot one (1) and, two (2) southwesterly and hundred  
feet, (200) feet to place of beginning.
