KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Rachel Bough, nee Childress, a full blood Creek Indian, roll number 3833 and John Bough, her husband, ^{parties}, of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three thousand five hundred and no^ors Dollars (\$ 3,500.00), in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto First Baptist of Broken Bow, Oklahoma ^{parties} of second part, the following-described real property and premises, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The west half (1/2) of the northeast quarter (NE 1/4) and the southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of the northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of section nineteen (19th) township eighteen (18th) range fourteen (4th) east of the Indiana Base and Meridian, containing one hundred and twenty (120) acres more or less,

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and warrant the title to the same.

To have and to hold said-described premises unto the said party of the second part, First heirs and assigns, forever; free, clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and other liens and encumbrances of whatsoever nature.
