

OIL AND GAS LEASE RECORD, No. 65.

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It is further expressly agreed that this lease is made with full knowledge of the fact that under the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior governing the leasing of land in the Indian Territory, lessees are prohibited from being directly or indirectly interested in leases, in their own names or in the names of other persons, or as owners or holders of stock in corporations, or as members of associations, covering an aggregate of more than 4,800 acres of land in the Choctaw, Chickasaw, Cherokee, Creek, and Seminole Nations, that the said prohibition is made a part and condition of this lease, and that the Secretary of the Interior reserves the right to cancel leases at any time during the period for which they are to run, after notice as herein mentioned, when he is satisfied that the terms of the lease or of the regulations heretofore or hereafter prescribed have been violated in any particular, and it further agree not to transfer, assign, or sublet, by working or drilling contract or otherwise, directly or indirectly, obtained and holds interests in leases of oil and gas properties in said Territory, said leases covering, in the aggregate, an area of more than 4,800 acres, and further finds that the property herein leased is a part of said aggregate area, then the Secretary of the Interior may cancel this lease in the same manner as provided for in the case of any violation of the terms of said lease.

It is further agreed and understood that before this lease shall be in force and effect the lessee shall furnish a bond to the satisfaction of the Secretary of the Interior, in accordance with the regulations prescribed by him, which shall be deposited and remain on file in the Indian Office.
