WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar
and other valuable considerations and ~~no~~ DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of
the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
The southerly 40 feet of Lot (1) in Block (99) in
the City of Tulsa Oklahoma according to the
government survey thereof and more particularly
described as follows: Beginning at the south
easterly corner of said lot therein in a northeasterly direction
along the easterly line of said lot a distance of 40 feet
thence in a southwesterly direction parallel with the
southerly line of said lot, a distance of 140 feet to the alley
thence in a southeasterly direction along the southerly
line of said lot a distance of 40 feet to the southerly line
of said lot; thence in a northeasterly direction along
the southerly line of said lot to place of beginning

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances

with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,
charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever, except several
last for 1909 and all subsequent years
and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, his heirs and
assigns, against said party of the first part his their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to
claim the same.
