This Indenture, Made this 25th day of September A.D. 1909
 between Joel L. Young a single man, party of the
 first part and Florence B. Hinckley
 County in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and
 party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
One hundred fifty and no 100 and no 100 DOLLARS.

The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
 and State of Oklahoma, to wit:

an undivided one-fourth interest, in east half of the north west quarter; the southwest quarter of the north east quarter, the north half of the north half of the southwest quarter all in section thirty two (32) township nineteen (19) north and range eleven (11) east of the Indian Base and meridian and containing one hundred and sixty acres more or less according to the government survey thereof subject to a certain oil and gas lease made to Beulah Oil & Gas Company and covering the northeast quarter of the north half of the southwest quarter of the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

Trump for \$600.00 and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
