between F. A. Gillespie and Maude Gillespie

County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Ida T.
Fletcher of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred
and Fifty (75.00) and DOLLARS,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of
the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot eight D in Block five (5)
Oak Grove Addition to City of Tulsa
Oklahoma

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said F. A. Gillespie and Maude Gillespie
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second
part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute
and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises
with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,
charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; except taxes
assessed

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, their heirs and
assigns, against said parties of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to
claim the same. The grantee covenants that no dwelling house shall be
constructed within fifteen years on said premises to cost
less than \$2000 and further that said premises shall never be sold to negroes.
