WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
One Thousand One Hundred and *DOLLARS*,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of
 the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of
 Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to wit:
 Lot six (6), Block ninety-eight (98) Tulsa
 Okla., as per the official Government survey
 of the City of Tulsa Okla.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.
 And said *R. E. Lynch & G. L. Lynch*
 for their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second
 part, that at the delivery of these presents *they are* lawfully seized in the full right of an absolute
 and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises
 with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,
 charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever, except taxes for
 1909 which are to be paid by the purchaser after balance of
 principal to be accounted for paid down
 and that *they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part their heirs and
 assigns, against said part of the first part — their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to
 claim the same.*
