WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Twenty five Thousand and ~~no~~ DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part of
the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
The southerly ~~end~~ feet of Lot
eleven(11) and ~~the~~ northerly forty-five
(45) feet of Lot ten(10) in Block nineteen
(19) in the town of North Tulsa, Okla-
homa, according to the Government
plat and survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said William W. Tamm and Ruby E. Tamm
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second
part, that at the delivery of these presents They are lawfully seized in their right of an absolute
and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises
with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,
charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that They will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part — heirs and
assigns, against said part of the first part — their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to
claim the same.
