the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part *4* of
the second part, *his* heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of *Tulsa*

addition to Tulsa Okla. according to the

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

assigns, against said part *1* of the first part *their* heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to
claim the same.
