This Indenture, Made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1909  
between Loss R. Stansberry and Myrtle L. Stans-  
Berry, his wife of  
Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and John H.  
Myrtle, and Ella Belle D. Lee his  
wife with fee to next in survivor of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred one hundred and one dollar and no DOLLARS,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Commencing thirty-two (32) feet west  
and two hundred two (202) feet south of the  
north east corner of the south west quarter (1/4) of the south  
west quarter (1/4) of the north west quarter (1/4) of section  
twelve (12) in Township nineteen (19) north of Range  
twelve (12) east running thence south one hundred  
100 feet, thence west one hundred twenty seven and  
one half (27 1/2) feet, thence north one hundred (100) feet  
thence east one hundred twenty seven and one half  
(27 1/2) feet to the place of beginning, the same being part of  
lot 13 numbered three and six in block numbered One. To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances

thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Loss R. Stansberry and Myrtle L. Stans-  
Berry, and their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second  
part, that at the delivery of these presents They are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute  
and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises  
with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,  
charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that They will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, their heirs and  
assigns, against said party of the first part, or their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same.
