This Indenture, Made this 25<sup>th</sup> day of August A. D. 1929 between Oklahoma Trust Company

of Okmulgee, Okmulgee County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Herman Steinbuechel and Marie Steinbuechel of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three thousand (\$3,000.00) and DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: The north half (N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>) of the southeast quarter (SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section twenty-five (25) township seventeen (17) north, range thirteen (13) east of the Indian Meridian.

Containing eighty (80) acres more or less according to the Government Survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Oklahoma Trust Company for its heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said parties of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents it is lawfully seized in its own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever, except any valid oil and gas lease that may be in this land, and it is understood that the said grantor reserves out half of all the oil, gas and other minerals and that it will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, against said part of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
