WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

Three Hundred and Twenty ————— DOLLARS,the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County ofTulsa and State of Oklahoma, to wit:

(2) block one hundred and fifty-eight(58) of the City of Tulsa
Oklahoma according to the official plat and survey thereof, being
a tract of uniform width of eight(8) feet and a uniform
depth of one hundred forty(14) feet in the south part
of the north fifty(50) feet of lot two(2) block one
hundred fifty-eight(58)To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.And said C. R. Kempf and Laura Jennings Kempf, his wife
for their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second

assigns, against said parties of the first part — their heirs and all and every person whomever, lawfully claiming or to
