WITNESSETH, The said part 1 of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby present, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 2 of
the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot number two (2) and lot number six (6) in block number
four (4) in section number twenty two (22) township
nineteen (19) north, range twelve (12) east, S. M. in the
town of Red Fork according to the United States Government
survey, as approved by the Secretary of the Interior which
is not occupied as a homestead and no part thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

and for his heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 2 of the second
part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute

with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles,
charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; except the back taxes

assigns, against said part 1 of the first part his heirs and all and every person, whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to
claim the same.
