This Indenture, Made this 30th day of October A. D. 1909 between Mrs. P. Merrell and Lucy Merrell, his wife of

Collinsville, Rogers County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Ed. F. Egan, of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One and other valuable property (C. O.) and 25 DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: The northeast (NE 1/4) quarter of the northwest (NW 1/4) quarter, and the north one half (N 1/2) of the southeast (SE 1/4) quarter of the northwest (NW 1/4) quarter, and the southwest (SW 1/4) quarter of the southeast (SE 1/4) quarter of the northwest (NW 1/4) quarter, of section twenty seven (27) township twenty one (21) north, range thirteen (13) east of the Indian Meridian, containing in all seventy (70) acres, more or less, according to the United States Government survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Mrs. P. Merrell and Lucy Merrell, his wife for themselves for heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;
