This Indenture, Made this 5th day of November A.D. 1909  
between Wm P. Merrill and Lucy Merrill his wife of Collinville

Oklahoma, County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and  
Ed T. Egan, of Tulsa, Okla. of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
Two thousand and no DOLLARS,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of  
the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of

Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:  
Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter, and the north half (½) of the  
southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of the  
southeast quarter and the northwest quarter of section twenty-one  
(21) township twenty-one (21) north range fifteen (15) east of the  
Indian Base Meridian, containing in all seventy (70) acres  
more or less according to the United States Government survey thereof

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances  
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Wm P. Merrill and Lucy Merrill, his wife,  
for themselves, their heirs, executors or administrators, do by covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second  
part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute  
and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises  
with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles,  
charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part their heirs and  
assigns, against said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same.
