WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred (100) and no/100 DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa

and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: Lots fifteen (15) sixteen (16) seventeen (17) and eighteen (18) in Block # fourteen (14) in Midland Addition to Bixby Oklahoma according to plat on file of said midland addition.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

Linkhart and Laura Linkhart, his wife for their heirs, executors or administrators, do here covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against said parties of the first part or their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
